- 4. The applicant must be a practicing Catholic, meaning he/she must have received the sacraments of Baptism and First Holy Communion.
- 5. The applicant must be a/or related to a parishioner of Holy Family Catholic Church in good standing.
- 6. Special consideration will be given to a Knight, child of or grandchild of a member of Council 7728 in good standing or a child or grandchild of a deceased member of Council 7728 who was in good standing at the time of death.
- 7. The applicant must submit three (3) letters of recommendation.
- 8. The awarded scholarship covenant:
 - A. The recipient will enroll at a college or university in the 2020 fall semester following graduation from high school. Past recipients and/or current college students are eligible for this scholarship.
 - B. The \$1,000 scholarship will be paid directly to the university or college and must be used for tuition, fees, books, and other education related expenses while attending a college or university for the fall semester. If the recipient drops out or withdraws from a college or university at midterm, a proportionate amount of the scholarship awarded may be requested by the Knights of Columbus Council 7728.
 - C. The recipient will portray good citizenship, service, leadership, and character in the community at all times.
 - D. Upon graduation from high school, the recipient will receive a letter explaining the procedures that must be followed to receive the scholarship funds.
- 9. Applicant must research and submit a 500-word essay on the topic: In a chaotic world, how can you make the world brighter? Referring to the Gospel of Matthew chapters 5-16, especially the Beatitudes, elaborate on this topic. The essay and application may be handwritten or typed.
